# History and Organization

- Incorporated in 2003 as US 501(c) Non-Profit Tax-exempt Organization
- Final Constitution adopted in 2004
- Generous funding from Philanthropist Dr. Hemprova Ghosh McDonald of Waco, Texas.
- Initial work in 'Purna Shiksha' . 'Purna Shikhshaytan' in 2008.
- Over the years

  - Disbursements totaling over \$127,000.

# Our Services

## Basic Education

- Purna Shiksha scheme was implemented in 3 schools.
- Currently sponsor 10 poor children for care and education at RVM in Joyrambati.
- Currently provide teaching assistance (tutorial) to 10 students in Grades10-11 at Purna Sikshayatan. Helped hire two teachers.
  - 30 Students were helped in past 3 years. All passed their grades.
- Donated fund to RVM towards establishing Vivekananda University. The land was purchased by RVM on B.T. Road near Titagarh.



# A few of the RVM kids who require sponsorship



Sundari Murmu belongs to a poor and destitute family. As her poor parents cannot give proper education and maintenance to the children, they admitted Sundari into our Mission for the same. Sundari is now studying in Class- I.



Rahul Mahato has come from a poor and distressed family. His father earns very little from cultivation. Naturally he finds it difficult to maintain the family and give proper education to the children. Rahul is now studying in Class-III.



# A few of the RVM kids who require sponsorship



Soma Murmu belongs to a poor and destitute family. Her father is a poor Private Tutor. He earns something which is not fixed and regular. So her father maintains the family with great hardship. He cannot think of giving proper education to the children. Soma is studying in Class-I.



Sudhanshu Murmu has come from a poor and distressed family. His father earn very little from cultivation. He finds it difficult to maintain the family and give proper education to the children. Sudhanshu is now studying in Class-III.

# Our Services

## Vocational Training

Provide employment-oriented training, such as welding, carpentry, sewing, electrical maintenance.

- Helped over 300 students over the years.
- Assistance to RVM, Barrackpore , Purulia and Joyrambati with new equipment and machineries to help develop their vocational training facility.
- Driving License Training for Motor mechanic students. Helped 25 students last year.





# Our Services

## Healthcare and Public Health

- Mobile Medical Van run by RVM was maintained for 4.5 years with funding from Dr Hemprova Ghosh for villages near Barrackpore, @Rs. 28,000 per month.
  - Helped several thousand over the years.
- Program on “Closed Garbage Containers – to make cities clean and reduce water logging”. Fabrication by RVM students.

# Going Forward

- Basic Education
  - Sponsor 20 additional destitute children for care and education at RVM. Cost \$6000.
  - Sponsor 15 additional Tutoring classes for higher grade students. Cost \$4500.
- Medical Care
  - Restart Mobile Medical Unit run by RVM. Cost RS 30,000 per month
- Vocational Training
  - Provide Teaching material, machinery, Driver education.
- Our Administrative expense is low < 8%
- Will continue to be watchful that money is spent wisely.
